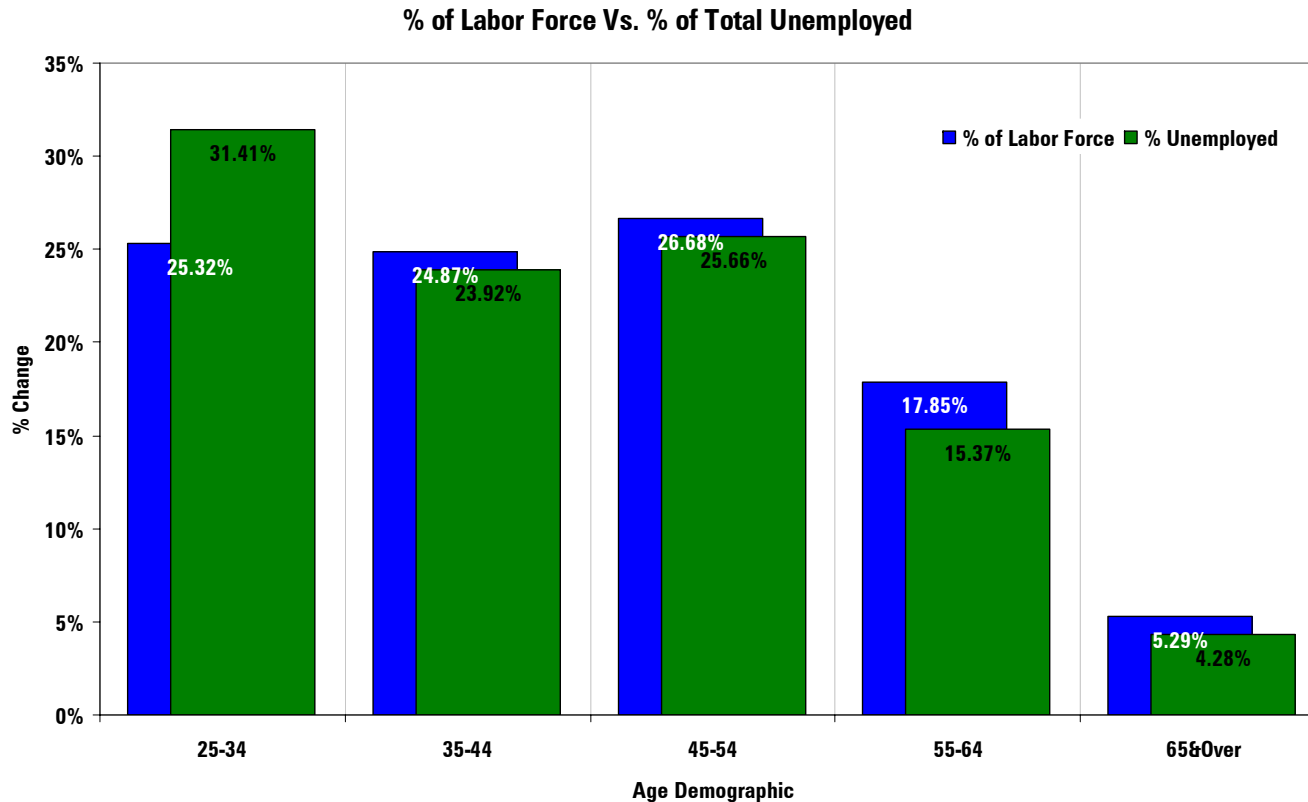


Disparity Between Age Groups in Labor Force and Unemployment: One Year Later



Workers in the range of 25-34 years of age have continued to make up more of the unemployed labor force than other age groups, proportionally. % of Total Unemployed decreased to 31.41% from 32.56%, partially due to a decrease of the group's overall contribution to labor force from 25.39% to 25.32%. In the chart above, columns would be of equal height if unemployment of each age group was proportional to its weight in the overall labor force.
