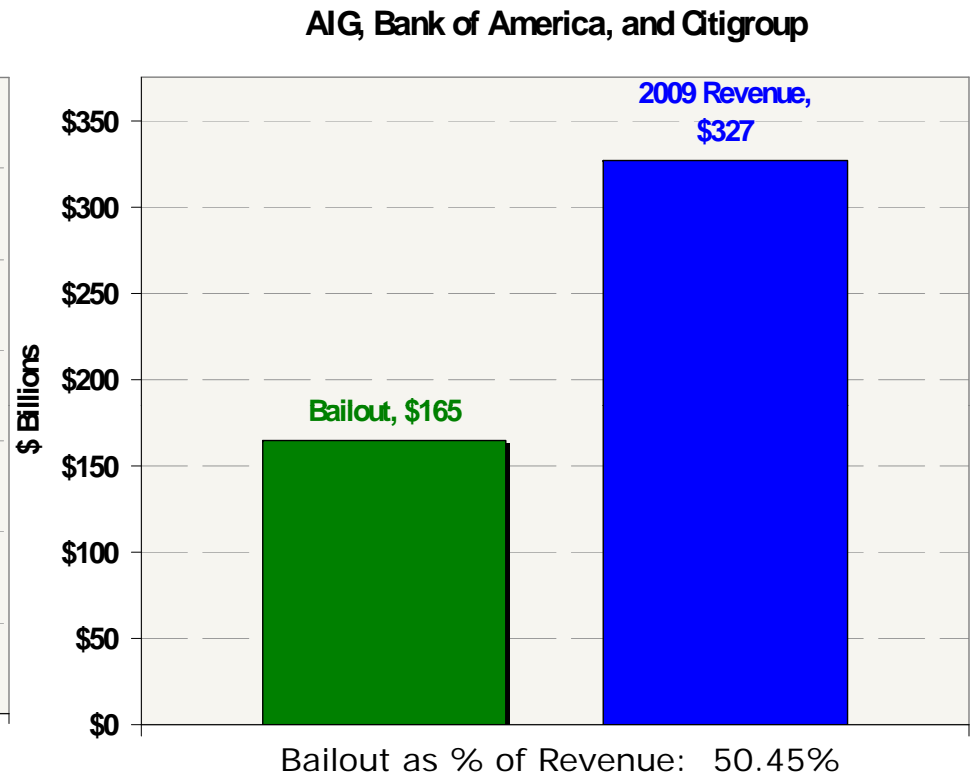
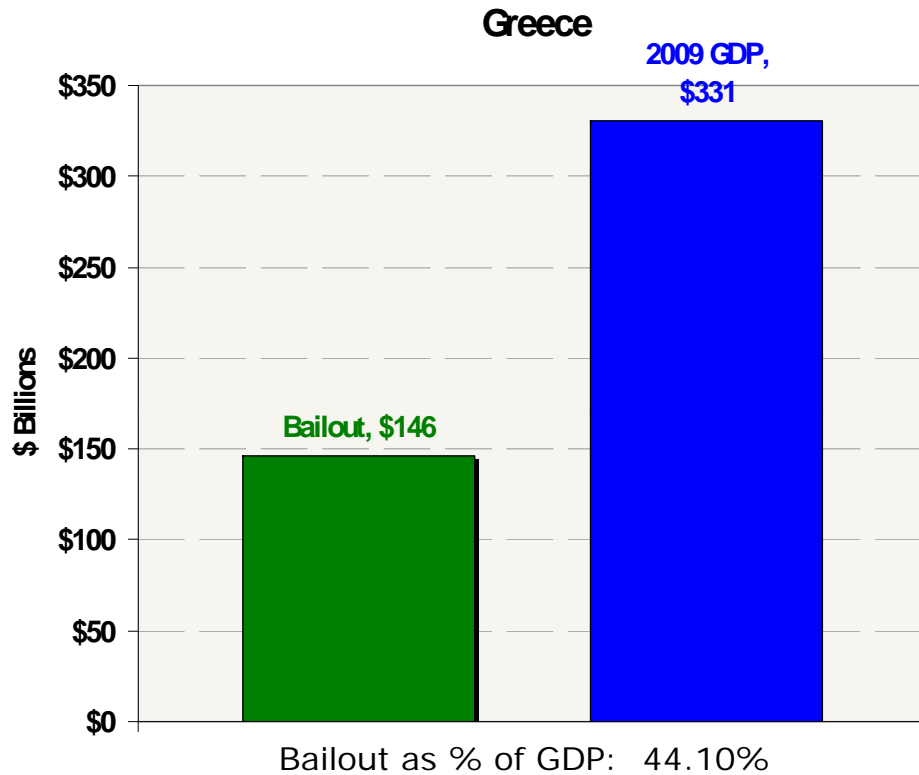


# The Greek Bailout In Perspective: Part I



- The \$146 Billion bailout of Greece, a state with annual GDP of \$331 Billion, has met significant resistance by some EU member states.
- The bailout is on par with the \$165 Billion bailout of three U.S. financial services companies with total Revenue in 2009 of \$327 Billion.
- The \$146 Billion commitment to Greece equates to approximately 20% of U.S. TARP Commitments.
